## What next?

Despite this, Uber, Cabify and DiDi are still able to **operate**, potentially without any problems for passengers.

Drivers alone, however, could face sanctions.

**Córdoba City Council** has <u>approved</u> increased fines for unauthorised transport services (amended **Article 181 of Ordinance 12.468**, Code of Civic Coexistence).
