The vice governor of **Tucumán** signed a decree that **repeals** the law (**Ley N° 9352**) allowing the use of transport applications in the province.

After the vice-governor repealed the law allowing digital platforms in the province, Uber drivers blocked the city centre.

What next?

Despite this, Uber, Cabify and DiDi are still able to **operate**, potentially without any problems for passengers.

Drivers alone, however, could face sanctions.

Córdoba City Council has approved **increased fines** for **unauthorised** transport services (amended **Article 181 of Ordinance 12.468**, Code of Civic Coexistence).

A few days after the elections, the Argentine judiciary suspended the labour reform included in the **Decree of Necessity and Urgency (DNU)** signed by **Javier Milei's** government.
