



Lyft and Uber drivers protested on **Valentine's Day** to demand a change in their set wages.



DoorDash raised fees for NYC deliveries due to the new **minimum wage law** and Department of Labor wage regulations.

Massachusetts **AG settles \$3.5M case** with Grubhub over violation of caps on third-party delivery fees during the pandemic.



From March, the US Department of Labour will require platforms to **offer benefits** like minimum wage and overtime pay to workers previously classified as contractors.



In 2023, Uber drivers have seen their **monthly earnings** fall by 17.1%.

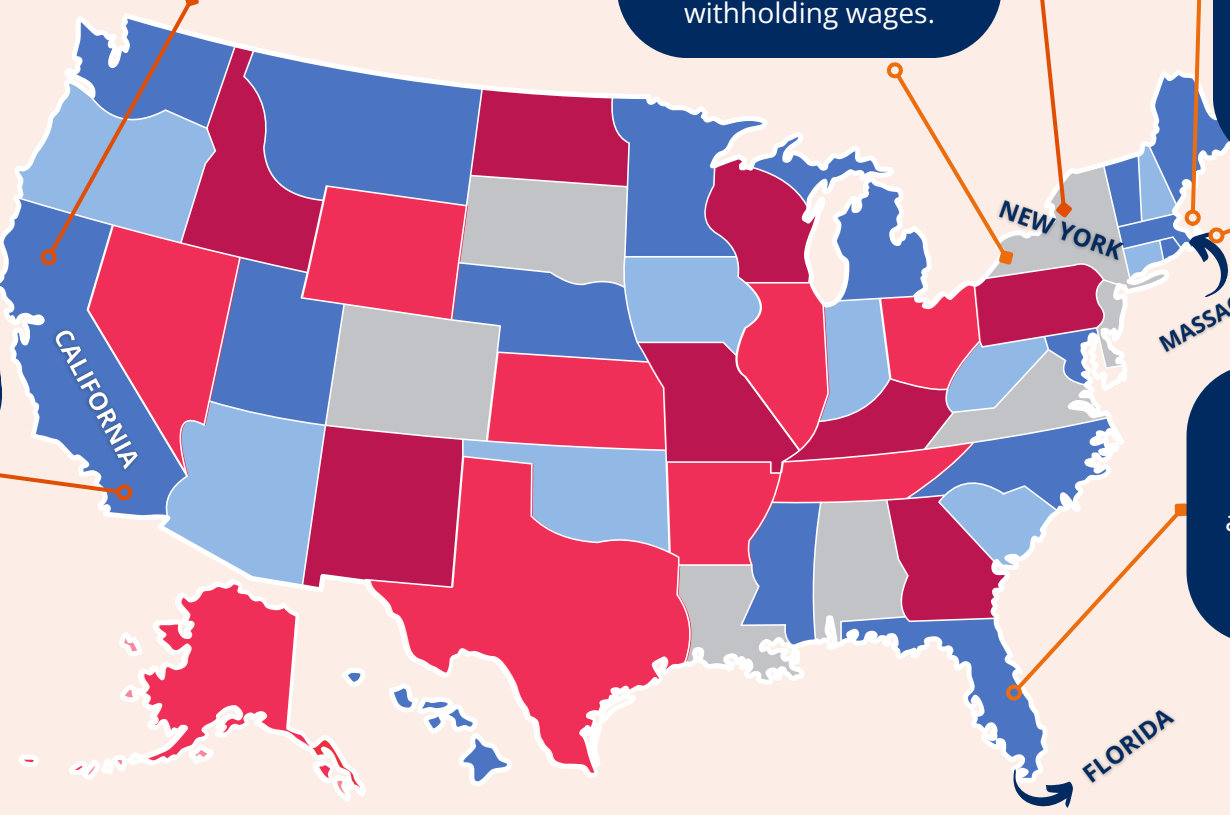
New York AG announced a \$328M **settlement** for Uber and Lyft drivers by March 1. The platforms were accused of withholding wages.
