Opera Workers' Ruling Offers Path for Uber, Lyft Drivers to Unionize

By voting in favor, the Democratic majority of the National Labor Relations Board has implemented a decision that **simplifies the process for workers to establish themselves as employees** rather than independent contractors, granting them the ability to organize and potentially paving the way for workers at companies such as Uber, Lyft, and DoorDash Inc. to assert their status as employees with the right to unionize.
