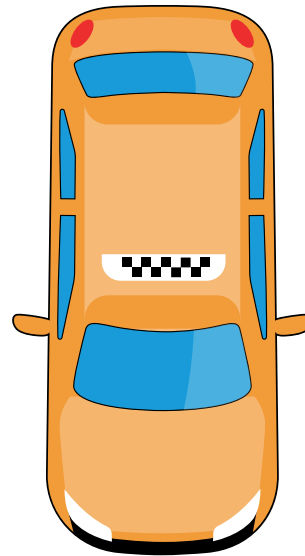
### WORKERS
